

## CRITERIA FOR CREATING A SISTER WORLD PEACE ROSE GARDEN

International World Peace Rose Gardens (IWPRG) has developed the following criteria to encourage cities to become a Sister Garden:

1. The host city/entity would provide a site that is open and accessible to the public.
2. A Sister garden would embrace the theme of one of IWPRG's major World Peace Rose Gardens; e.g., the ideals of nonviolence, peace and love (the Martin Luther King, Jr. WPRG).
3. The Sister Garden is welcome to implement the Inspirational Messages of Peace Contest or other youth programs of IWPRG.
4. IWPRG will provide guidance and technical support for the development of the project, as well as rose-growing technologies, if requested.
5. The garden will have a marker/sign identifying it as an official Sister Garden to another World Peace Rose Garden.
6. The host city/entity will be responsible for the cost and maintenance of the garden.
