## CRITERIA FOR CREATING A SISTER WORLD PEACE ROSE GARDEN

## International World Peace Rose Gardens (IWPRG) has developed the following criteria to encourage cities to become a Sister Garden:

- 1. The host city/entity would provide a site that is open and accessible to the public.
- 2. A Sister garden would embrace the theme of one of IWPRG's major World Peace Rose Gardens; e.g., the ideals of nonviolence, peace and love (the Martin Luther King, Jr. WPRG).
- 3. The Sister Garden is welcome to implement the Inspirational Messages of Peace Contest or other youth programs of IWPRG.
- 4. IWPRG will provide guidance and technical support for the development of the project, as well as rose-growing technologies, if requested.
- 5. The garden will have a marker/sign identifying it as an official Sister Garden to another World Peace Rose Garden.
- 6. The host city/entity will be responsible for the cost and maintenance of the garden.
